JANUARY 30, 2026 (“RECORD DATE”), ON A PROPORTIONATE BASIS, THROUGH THE “TENDER OFFER” ROUTE, AT A PRICE OF ₹655 (RUPEES SIX HUNDRED AND FIFTY FIVE ONLY) PER EQUITY SHARE (THE “BUYBACK PRICE”), PAYABLE IN CASH, FOR AN AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING ₹ 5,850 LAKHS (RUPEES FIVE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY LAKHS ONLY), EXCLUDING TRANSACTION COSTS (THE “BUYBACK SIZE”). The Buyback is in accordance with Article 16 of the Articles of Association of the Company and Sections 68, 69, 70, 110 and all other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, (the “**Act**”), and applicable rules made thereunder including the Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014, (“**Share Capital Rules**”), Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended, to the extent applicable, in compliance with the SEBI Buyback Regulations read with the SEBI Circulars and the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (“**SEBI Listing Regulations**”), and including any amendments, statutory modifications or re- enactments thereof, for the time being in force and subject to such other approvals, permissions, consents, exemptions and sanctions as may be necessary and subject to such conditions and modifications, if any, as may be prescribed or imposed by the appropriate authorities while granting such approvals, permissions, consents, exemptions and sanctions as may be required from time to time from any statutory and/ or regulatory authorities including but not limited to Securities and Exchange Board of India, National Stock Exchange of India Limited, BSE Limited, Registrar of Companies, Reserve Bank of India, etc.
2. The Buyback Size is 24.68% and 24.81% of the aggregate of the total paid-up equity share capital and free reserves (including securities premium account) as per the audited standalone and consolidated financial statements of the Company as on March 31, 2025 respectively (the latest audited standalone and consolidated financial statements available for the financial year as on the date of the Board meeting approving the proposal of the Buyback, held on December 15, 2025) and is within the statutory limits of 25% of the total paid-up equity share capital and free reserves (including securities premium account) as per the latest audited standalone and consolidated financial statements of the Company for financial year ended March 31, 2025. The Equity Shares proposed to be bought back represent 4.14 % of the total number of Equity Shares in the total paid-up Equity Share capital of the Company, as on March 31, 2025.
3. The Letter of Offer will be sent electronically to the Equity Shareholder(s)/ Beneficial Owner(s) holding Equity Shares of the Company as on the Record Date i.e. January 30, 2026.

5. The procedure for Acceptance is set out in Clause 20 (*Process and Methodology for the Buyback*) on page 33 of this Letter of Offer. The payment of consideration is in cash to the Eligible Shareholders. 6. Equity Shareholders are advised to refer to Clause 18 (*Details of the Statutory Approvals*) and Clause 22 (*Note on Taxation*) on pages 31 and 43 respectively of this Letter of Offer, before tendering their Equity Shares in the Buyback.

7. The maximum number of Equity Shares proposed to be bought back under the Buyback will not exceed 25% of the total number of Equity shares in the total paid-up Equity Share capital of the Company;
8. There are no pending schemes of amalgamation or compromise or arrangement pursuant to the Act (“Scheme”) involving the Company, and no public announcement of the Buyback shall be made during pendency of any such Scheme;
9. The Company shall not make any further offer of Buyback within a period of one year reckoned from the expiry of the Buyback period i.e. date on which the payment of consideration to shareholders who have accepted the Buyback offer is made;
10. The Company shall not withdraw the Buyback offer after the public announcement of the Buyback offer is made.
11. The Company shall comply with the statutory and regulatory timelines in respect of the Buyback in such manner as prescribed under the Act and/or the SEBI Buyback Regulations and any other applicable laws;

There are no defaults (either in the past or subsisting) in the repayment of deposits, interest payment thereon, redemption of debentures or payment of interest thereon or redemption of preference shares or payment of dividend due to any shareholder, or repayment of any term loans or interest payable thereon to any financial institution or banking company as the case may be;
16. The Company will not Buyback Equity Shares which are locked-in or non-transferable, until the pendency of such lock-in, or until the Equity Shares become transferable, as applicable, during the period between the date of opening and closing of the Buyback offer;

The Equity Shares bought back by the Company will be extinguished and/or physically destroyed as may be applicable in the manner prescribed under the SEBI Buyback Regulations and the Act within 7 (seven) working days of the date of payment of consideration to shareholders who have tendered the Equity Shares under the Buyback offer.
25. 5. DETAILS OF THE PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT

In accordance with the provisions of Regulation 7(i) of the SEBI Buyback Regulations, the Company has made a Public Announcement dated January 21, 2026 for the Buyback of Equity Shares, which was published on January 22, 2026 in all editions of the Financial Express (English national daily), Jansatta (Hindi national daily) and Makkal Kural, a Tamil daily newspaper (Tamil being the regional language at the place where the registered office of the Company is situated), each with wide circulation. The Public Announcement dated January 21, 2026 was published on January 22, 2026 within 2 (two) working days from the date of declaration of results of passing the special resolution by the Equity Shareholders approving the Buyback through postal ballot, i.e. Tuesday, January 20, 2026. A copy of the Public Announcement is available on the Company's website (www.matrimony.com), the Manager to the Buy- back i.e., www.saffronadvisor.com, and is expected to be available on the website of SEBI (www.sebi.gov.in) during the Buyback period and on the website of Stock Exchanges i.e. www.bseindia.com and www.nseindia.com. The Company will publish further notices or corrigenda, if any, in the abovementioned newspapers. After dispatch of the Letter of Offer, the Company will publish an advertisement in all editions of the Financial Express (English national daily), Jansatta (Hindi national daily) and Makkal Kural, a Tamil daily newspaper (Tamil being the regional language at the place where the registered office of the Company is situated), each with wide circulation to inform the Eligible Shareholders about the

completion of dispatch of letter of offer. The dispatch advertisement will also include the link for shareholders to check their entitlement under the Buy-back.

6. DETAILS OF THE BUYBACK

- a. The Board of Directors of Matrimony.com Limited (the “**Company**”) at its meeting held on December 15, 2025 (“**Board Meeting**”) has, in accordance with Article 16 of the Articles of Association of the Company and in accordance with the provisions of Sections 68, 69, 70, 110 and all other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended (“**Act**”) read with the Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014, the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and other relevant Rules made thereunder, each as amended from time to time and the provisions of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Buy-Back of Securities) Regulations, 2018, as amended (“**SEBI Buyback Regulations**”), the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, (“**SEBI Listing Regulations**”) and subject to such other approvals, permissions, consents, sanctions and exemptions of Securities and Exchange Board of India (“**SEBI**”), the stock exchanges on which the Equity Shares of the Company are listed (“**Stock Exchanges**”), Reserve Bank of India (“**RBI**”) and/or other authorities, institutions or bodies (together with SEBI and RBI, the “**Appropriate Authorities**”), as may be necessary, and subject to such conditions, alterations, amendments and modifications as may be prescribed or imposed by them while granting such approvals, permissions, consents, sanctions and exemptions which may be agreed by the Board of Directors of the Company, and subject to the approval of the shareholders of the Company by way of special resolution through postal ballot including e-voting process, the Board of Directors of the Company (“**Board**”, which term shall be deemed to include Buyback committee of the Board and/or officials, which the Board had constituted/authorised to exercise its powers, including the powers conferred by this resolution), has approved the Buyback by the Company of its fully paid-up equity shares having a face value of ₹ 5 (Rupees Five only) each (“**Equity Shares**”), for an amount not exceeding ₹ 5,850 Lakhs (Rupees Five Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty lakhs only) excluding any expenses incurred or to be incurred for the Buyback viz. brokerage costs, fees, turnover charges, taxes such as securities transaction tax, goods and services tax and other taxes (if any) stamp duty, advisors fees, filing fees, public announcement expenses, printing and dispatch expenses, if any, and other incidental and related expenses and charges etc. (“**Transaction Costs**”) (such amount hereinafter referred to as the “**Maximum Buyback Size**”), being 24.68% and 24.81% of the aggregate of the total paid-up Equity Share capital and free reserves of the Company based on the latest standalone and consolidated audited financial statements of the Company respectively as at March 31, 2025, at a Buyback price not exceeding ₹ 5,850 Lakhs (Rupees Five Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Lakhs only) per Equity Share (“**Maximum Buyback Price**”), payable in cash, from the shareholders/beneficial owners of the Equity Shares of the Company as on a record date to be subsequently decided by the Buyback Committee (“**Record Date**”), through the “**Tender Offer**” route, on a proportionate basis as prescribed under the SEBI Buyback Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the “**Buyback**”);
- b. The Company sought approval of its shareholders for the Buyback, by a special resolution through postal ballot. The shareholders approved the proposal of Buyback of Equity Shares and the results of the postal ballot were announced on January 20, 2026.
- c. The Equity Shares of the Company are listed on the BSE Limited (the “**BSE**”) and the National Stock Exchange of India Limited (the “**NSE**”) (herein together referred to as the “**Stock Exchanges**”).
- d. In terms of Regulation 5 of the SEBI Buyback Regulations, the Board may, till one working day prior to the Record Date, increase the Buyback Price and decrease the number of Equity Shares proposed to be bought back, such that there is no change in the Buyback Size. As on the date of this Letter of Offer, there is no change in the Buyback Price.
- e. Subsequent to the approval by the shareholders through the postal ballot, a committee of the Board and officials, which the Board has constituted/authorised to exercise its powers in relation to the Buyback (the “**Buyback Committee**”) in its meeting held on December 15, 2025 has determined the final Buyback Price of ₹655/- (Rupees Six Hundred and Fifty Five only) per Equity Share. The Company will buy back upto 8,93,129 (Eight Lakhs And Ninety Three Thousand One Hundred And Twenty Nine) Equity Shares, constituting 4.14% of the total number of the Equity Shares in the paid-up Equity Share capital of the Company as on March 31, 2025 at the Buyback Price for an amount upto ₹ 5,850 Lakhs (Rupees Five Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Lakhs only) excluding the Transaction Costs, on a proportionate basis from the Eligible Shareholders through the tender offer route, in accordance with Regulation 4(iv)(a) of the SEBI Buy Back Regulations and the Act, as amended. The Equity Shares of the Company are currently listed on the Stock Exchanges.
- f. The Buyback shall be undertaken on a proportionate basis from the Eligible Shareholders through the tender offer route prescribed under the SEBI Buyback Regulations. Additionally, the Buy Back shall be implemented by the Company using the “Mechanism for acquisition of shares through Stock Exchange” as specified by SEBI vide circular bearing number CIR/CFD/POLICYCELL/1/2015 dated April 13, 2015 read with circular bearing number CFD/DCR2/CIR/P/2016/131 dated December 9, 2016 and read with circular CFD/DCR-III/CIR/P/2021/615 dated August 13, 2021 and SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2/P/CIR/2023/35 dated March 08, 2023 including any amendments thereof. In this regard, the Company has requested BSE Limited to provide the separate acquisition window to facilitate placing of sell orders by the Eligible Shareholders who wish to tender Equity Shares in the Buyback. For the purposes of the Buy Back, BSE Limited is appointed as the designated stock exchange. Once the Buyback is concluded, all Equity Shares purchased by the Company in the Buyback will be extinguished in terms of the SEBI Buyback Regulations.
- g. The Buyback is subject to other approvals, permissions and exemptions as may be required from time to time from any statutory and/ or regulatory authority including SEBI and the Stock Exchanges.

h. The shareholding of the Promoter and Promoter Group of the Company (the “Promoter and Promoter Group”) and persons acting in concert as on the date of the Public Announcement i.e. January 21, 2026 and date of publication of the Public Announcement i.e. January 22, 2026:

7. INTENTION OF THE PROMOTER AND PROMOTER GROUP

- In terms of the Buyback Regulations, under the tender offer route, the Promoter, members of the Promoter Group and person acting in concert of the Company, have the option to participate in the Buyback. In this regard, the promoter, member of promoter group and person acting in concert vide their respective letters dated December 15, 2025 have expressed their intention not to participate in the Buyback.
- The Promoter and Promoter Group of the Company hold 54.61% of Equity Shares in the total outstanding equity share capital of the Company. For details with respect to Promoter and Promoter Group shareholding post Buyback please refer Clause 14.h of this Letter of Offer. Post Buyback the public shareholding of the Company shall not fall below the minimum level required as per Regulation 38 of the SEBI Listing Regulations, and the provisions contained under Rule 19 (2) (b) and Rule 19A of the Securities Contract (Regulation) Rules, 1957 read with SEBI circular dated February 22, 2018.

8. AUTHORITY FOR THE BUYBACK

- The Buyback is being undertaken by the Company in accordance with the provision of Article 16 of the Articles of Association, the provisions of section 68, 69, 70, 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, the SEBI Listing Regulations and the SEBI Buyback Regulations. The Buyback is subject to such other approvals and permissions, as may be necessary, from time to time required from statutory, regulatory or governmental authorities under applicable law, including but not limited to SEBI and Stock Exchanges.
- The Board at its meeting dated December 15, 2025 passed a resolution approving the Buyback of Equity Shares of the Company and sought approval of the Equity Shareholders, by way of a special resolution, through Postal Ballot Notice. The results of the postal ballot (e-voting) was declared on January 20, 2026. The Equity Shareholders have approved the Buyback by way of a special resolution, through the postal ballot (including e-voting) in accordance with the provisions of Section 110 of the Act and the rules thereunder, as aforesaid. The final terms of Buy Back were decided by Buyback Committee at its meeting held on January 20, 2026.

9. NECESSITY FOR THE BUYBACK

The Company has been generating significant amounts of cash on an ongoing basis and is a debt free entity. The current Buyback proposal is in line with the Company’s capital allocation practices of returning excess cash to shareholders, thereby increasing shareholder value in the longer term, and improving the Return on Equity. The Company believes that the Buyback is being undertaken by the Company after taking into account the operational and strategic cash requirements of the Company in the medium term and for returning surplus funds to the shareholders in an effective and efficient manner. The Buyback is being undertaken for the following reasons:

- The Buyback will help the Company to distribute surplus cash to its shareholders holding Equity Shares thereby enhancing the overall return to shareholders;
- The Buyback, which is being implemented through the tender offer route as prescribed under the SEBI Buyback Regulations, would involve a reservation of up to 15% of the Equity Shares, which the Company proposes to buyback, for small shareholders or the actual number of Equity Shares entitled as per the shareholding of small shareholders on the Record Date, whichever is higher. The Company believes that this reservation for small shareholders would benefit a significant number of the Company’s public shareholders, who would be classified as “Small Shareholders”.

- c) The Buyback is generally expected to improve return on equity through distribution of cash and improve earnings per share by reduction in the equity base of the Company, thereby leading to long term increase in shareholders' value; and
- d) The Buyback gives an option to the Eligible Shareholders to either (A) participate in the Buyback and receive cash in lieu of their Equity Shares which are accepted under the Buyback, or (B) not to participate in the Buyback and get a resultant increase in their percentage shareholding in the Company post the Buyback, without additional investment.

10. MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS AND THE LIKELY IMPACT OF BUYBACK ON THE COMPANY

- a) The Buyback is not likely to cause any material impact on the profitability/ earnings of the Company except to the extent of reduction in the amount available for investment, which the Company could have otherwise deployed towards generating investment income. Assuming that the response to the Buyback is to the extent of 100% (full acceptance) from all the Eligible Shareholders up to their Buyback Entitlement, the funds deployed by the Company towards the Buyback would be upto ₹ 5,850 Lakhs (Rupees Five Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Lakhs only), excluding the Transaction Costs.
- b) The Buyback will not in any manner impair the ability of the Company to pursue growth opportunities or meet its cash requirements for business operations. The Buyback is expected to contribute to the overall enhancement of the shareholder value and result in an increase in the return on equity of the Company.
- c) In terms of the SEBI Buyback Regulations, under the Tender Offer route, the Promoter and Promoter Group and Person Acting in Concert of the Company have an option to participate in the Buyback. In this regard, the promoter, member of promoter group and person acting in concert vide their respective letters dated December 15, 2025 have expressed their intention not to participate in the Buyback.
- d) Assuming response to the Buyback is to the extent of 100% (full acceptance) from all the Eligible Shareholders up to their entitlement, the aggregate shareholding of the Promoter and Promoter Group after the completion of the Buyback shall become 56.96% of the post-Buyback total paid-up equity share capital of the Company from 54.61% of the pre-Buyback total paid-up equity share capital of the Company (as on the date of the Public Announcement), and the aggregate shareholding of the public in the Company shall become 43.04% of the post-Buyback total paid-up equity share capital of the Company from 45.39% of the pre-Buyback total paid-up equity share capital of the Company.
- e) The Buyback shall not result in a change in control or otherwise affect the existing management structure of the Company.
- f) Consequent to the Buyback and based on the number of Equity Shares bought back from the Eligible Non-Resident Shareholders, Indian financial institutions, banks, mutual funds and the public including other bodies corporate, the shareholding pattern of the Company would undergo a change. The FIIs / FPIs are advised to ensure that their investment in the Company continue to be within the limit prescribed under applicable laws, post completion of the Buyback.
- g) The debt-equity ratio after the completion of the Buyback on standalone as well as consolidated basis will be within the permissible limit of 2:1 prescribed under Section 68(2)(d) of Companies Act and Regulation 4(ii) of the Buyback Regulations, even if the response to the Buyback is to the extent of 100% (full acceptance) from all the Eligible Shareholders. As on March 31, 2025, our Company had no debt.
- h) The Company shall not raise further capital for a period of one year from the expiry of the Buyback period, i.e., the date on which the payment of consideration is made to the shareholders who have accepted the Buyback, except in discharge of its subsisting obligations such as conversion of warrants, stock option schemes, sweat equity or conversion of preference shares or debentures into Equity Shares.
- i) As per Regulation 24 (i) (b) of the Buyback Regulation, the Company shall not issue and allot any equity shares or specified securities (including by way of bonus or convert any outstanding ESOPs/outstanding instruments into Equity Shares) from the date of resolution passed by the Shareholders approving the Buyback till the expiry of the Buyback period, i.e., the date on which the payment of consideration is made to the shareholders who have accepted the Buyback;
- j) The Promoters and members of promoter group, and their associates be advised that they shall not deal in the Equity Shares or other specified securities of the Company either through the stock exchanges or off-market transactions (including inter-se transfer of Equity Shares among the promoters and members of promoter group) from the date of Board resolution till the closing of the Buyback offer.

12. SOURCES OF FUNDS FOR THE BUYBACK

- a) Assuming full acceptance, the funds that would be utilized by the Company for the purpose of the Buyback would be ₹ 5,850 Lakhs (Rupees Five Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Lakhs only), excluding the Transaction Costs.
- b) The Buyback would be financed out of Free Reserves of the Company. The Company shall transfer from its Free Reserves or securities premium account and/or such sources as may be permitted by law, a sum equal to the nominal value of the Equity Shares bought back through the Buyback to the Capital Redemption Reserve Account and the details of such transfer shall be disclosed in its subsequent audited financial statements. The Manager to the Buyback is empowered to operate the Escrow Account in accordance with the SEBI Buyback Regulations. In accordance with Regulation 9(xi) of the SEBI Buyback Regulations, the Company, on January 23, 2026 has deposited ₹ 14,62,50,000 (Rupees Fourteen Crore Sixty Two Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) in cash in the Escrow Account which is equal to 25% of the maximum consideration payable in the Buyback as the Buyback size is less than ₹ 100 crore and 10% thereafter of the Buyback Offer Size in accordance with the Buyback Regulations.
- b) In accordance with Regulation 10 of the SEBI Buyback Regulations, the Company shall immediately after the closure of the Tendering Period deposit the amount of consideration payable to the Eligible Shareholders in a special escrow account with the Escrow Agent. Such consideration would be the aggregate of 90% of the amount lying in the Escrow Account and the balance amount payable to the Eligible Shareholders and will constitute the entire sum due and payable as consideration for the Buyback in terms of the SEBI Buyback Regulations.
- c) The Company has firm financial resources to fulfil the obligations under the Buyback and the same has been certified by N S Shastri & Co, Chartered Accountants (ICAI Firm Registration No.: 0150935; Signing Partner's Membership No.:037676) having their office at #708/1, 6th B Cross, 3rd Block, Koramangala, Bangalore -560034, Karnataka, India vide a certificate dated January 21, 2026.
- d) Based on the aforementioned certificate, the Manager to the Buyback confirms that it is satisfied that firm arrangements for fulfilling the obligations under the Buyback are in place and that the Company has the ability to implement the Buyback in accordance with the SEBI Buyback Regulations.

- The Board at its meeting held on December 15, 2025, approved the proposal for the Buyback and by Equity Shareholders by a special resolution through postal ballot, the results of which were declared on January 20, 2026.

- c) The Buyback from each Eligible Shareholder is subject to all statutory consents and approvals as may be required by such Eligible Shareholder under applicable laws and regulations including from SEBI and/ or NSE or BSE. The Eligible Shareholder shall be solely responsible for obtaining all such statutory consents and approvals (including, without limitation the approvals from the Reserve Bank of India, if any) as may be required by them in order to sell their Equity Shares to the Company pursuant to the Buyback. An Eligible Shareholder would be required to provide copies of all such consents and approvals obtained by them to the Registrar to the Buyback.
- d) The Buyback from Non-Resident Shareholders will be subject to approvals, if any, of the appropriate authorities as applicable. Non-Resident Indians (“NRI”) and erstwhile Overseas Corporate Bodies (“OCB”) and Foreign Institutional Investors (FIIs) / Foreign Portfolio Investors (FPIs), and members of foreign nationality, if any, etc., must obtain all approvals required to tender the Equity Shares held by them in this Buyback (including without limitation the approval from RBI). It is the obligation of such non-resident shareholders, NRI, OCB shareholders, to obtain such approvals and submit such approvals along with the tender form, so as to enable them to tender Equity Shares in the buyback and for the Company to purchase such Equity Shares, tendered. The Company will have the right to make payment to the Eligible Shareholders in respect of whom no prior RBI approval is required and not accept Equity Shares from the Eligible Shareholders in respect of whom prior RBI approval is required in the event copies of such approvals are not submitted. By agreeing to participate in the Buyback, the Non-Resident Shareholders give the Company the authority to make, sign, execute, deliver, acknowledge and perform all applications to file regulatory reporting’s, if required, including FC-TRS form, if necessary and undertake to provide assistance to the Company for such regulatory reporting, if required by the Company.
- e) As of date of this Letter of Offer, there is no other statutory or regulatory approval required by the Company to implement the Buyback, other than that indicated above. If any statutory or regulatory approvals become applicable subsequently, the Buyback will be subject to such statutory or regulatory approvals. In the event that the receipt of any statutory/ regulatory approvals are delayed, changes to the proposed timetable of the Buyback, if any, shall be intimated to BSE and NSE.
- f) As on the date of the Letter of Offer and pursuant to the Buyback, the Company has not breached any covenant with the lenders and therefore, no prior approval needs to be obtained from the lenders.

20. PROCESS AND METHODOLOGY FOR THE BUYBACK

- I. The Company proposes to Buyback upto 8,93,129 (Eight Lakh Ninety Three Thousand One Hundred and Twenty Nine) fully paid-up Equity Shares at a price of ₹655 (Rupees Six Hundred and Fifty Five only) per Equity Share, payable in cash for an aggregate amount of upto ₹ 5,850 Lakhs (Rupees Five Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Lakhs only) excluding expenses incurred or to be incurred for the Buyback, which represents 24.68% and 24.81% of the aggregate of the paid-up equity share capital and free reserves (including securities premium account) of the Company as per the latest audited standalone and consolidated financial statements of the Company as on March 31, 2025 respectively through the tender offer route, on a proportionate basis from all the Equity Shareholders/beneficial owners of the equity shares of the Company as on the Record Date. The number of Equity Shares proposed to be bought back represents 4.14% of the total number of Equity Shares in the total paid-up Equity Share capital of the Company, as on March 31, 2025. The Buyback is in accordance with the provisions of Section 68, 69, 70, 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act and in accordance with Article 16 of the Articles of Association of the Company and subject to Regulation 4(iv) and other applicable provisions contained in the SEBI Buyback Regulations and such other approvals, permissions and exemptions as may be required, from time to time from statutory authorities and/ or regulatory authorities, including but not limited to SEBI, BSE, NSE and/or the RBI. The Equity Shareholders approved the Buyback by way of a special resolution through postal ballot, the results of which were announced on January 20, 2026. The Buyback Size does not exceed 25% of the fully paid-up equity share capital and free reserves as per the latest audited standalone and consolidated financial statements of the Company for the financial year ended March 31, 2025, respectively.
- II. The Company expresses no opinion as to whether Eligible Shareholders should participate in the Buyback and, accordingly, Eligible Shareholders may take their own decision after consulting their own advisors, as they may deem fit, regarding their participation in the Buyback.
- III. The aggregate shareholding of the Promoter and Promoter Group as at the date of the Public Announcement is 1,17,74,726 Equity Shares which represents 54.61% of the existing paid-up equity share capital of the Company. In terms of the SEBI Buyback Regulations, under the tender offer route, the Promoters and Promoter Group of the Company have the option to participate in the Buyback. In this regard, the Promoters and Promoter Group have expressed their intention vide their respective letter dated December 15, 2025 not to participate in the Buyback offer.
- IV. Assuming response to the Buyback is to the extent of 100% (full acceptance) from all the Eligible Shareholders up to their Buyback Entitlement, the aggregate shareholding of the Promoter and Promoter Group post the Buyback may increase to 59.96% from 54.61% prior to the Buyback (as on the date of the Public Announcement) and the aggregate shareholding of the public Shareholders in the Company may decrease to 43.04% post Buyback from the current pre Buyback shareholding of 45.39%.

V. Record Date and Ratio of Buyback as per the Buyback Entitlement in each Category:

- a) The Buyback Committee vide its resolution dated January 20, 2026 announced January 30, 2026 as the Record Date for the purpose of determining the Buyback Entitlement and the names of the Equity Shareholders who are eligible to participate in the Buyback i.e. Eligible Shareholders.
- b) The Equity Shares to be bought back as a part of this Buyback are divided into two categories:
 - i. Reserved category for Small Shareholders (“Reserved Category”); and
 - ii. General Category for other Eligible Shareholders (“General Category”).
- c) As defined under Regulation 2(i)(n) of the SEBI Buyback Regulations, a “Small Shareholder” is a shareholder of the Company who holds Equity Shares having market value, on the basis of closing price on BSE or NSE (as applicable, contingent on highest trading volume in respect of Equity Shares as on Record Date) as on the Record Date, of not more than ₹ 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh only). As on the Record Date, the volume of Equity Shares traded on NSE was 66,156 Equity Shares and on BSE was 6,279 Equity Shares. Accordingly, NSE being the exchange with highest trading volume, the closing price was ₹ 517.35 and hence all Eligible Shareholders holding not more than 386 Equity Shares as on the Record Date are classified as “Small Shareholders” for the purpose of the Buyback Offer.
- d) Based on the above definition, there are 26,832 Small Shareholders in the Company with aggregate shareholding of 12,54,989 Equity Shares as on the Record Date, which constitutes 5.82% of the outstanding number of Equity Shares of the Company as on Record Date and 140.52% of the maximum number of Equity Shares which the Company proposes to buy back as a part of this Buyback.
- e) In compliance with Regulation 6 of the SEBI Buyback Regulations, the reservation for the Small Shareholders, will be higher of:
 - i. Fifteen percent of the number of Equity Shares which the Company proposes to buy back i.e. 15% of 8,93,129 Equity Shares which works out to 1,33,970 Equity Shares; or
 - ii. The number of Equity Shares to which the Small Shareholders are entitled as per their shareholding as on Record Date i.e. (12,54,989/ 97,88,696) x 8,93,129 which works out to be 1,14,507 Equity Shares.

All the outstanding fully paid-up Equity Shares excluding shares held by Promoter and Promoter Group have been used for computing the Buyback Entitlement of Small Shareholders as the Promoter and Promoter Group do not intend to participate in the Buyback.

Based on the above analysis and in accordance with Regulation 6 of the SEBI Buyback Regulations, 1,33,970 Equity Shares have been reserved for the Small Shareholders (“**Reserved Category**”) and accordingly, the General Category for all other Eligible Shareholders shall consist of 7,59,159 Equity Shares (“**General Category**”).

f) Based on the above Buyback Entitlements, the ratio of Buyback for both categories is decided as below:

Category of Shareholders	Indicative Entitlement Ratio of Buyback *
Reserved category for Small Shareholders	8 Equity Shares out of every 75 fully paid-up Equity Shares held on the Record Date.
General category for all other Eligible Shareholders	4 Equity Shares out of every 45 fully paid-up Equity Shares held on the Record Date.

**The above Ratio of Buyback is approximate and providing indicative Buyback Entitlement. Any computation of entitled Equity Shares using the above Ratio of Buyback may provide a slightly different number due to rounding-off. The actual Buyback Entitlement for Reserved category for Small Shareholders is 10.6749939640905% and General category for all other Eligible Shareholders is 8.89600498353178%.*

VI. Fractional Entitlements:

- a) If the Buyback Entitlement, after applying the above-mentioned ratios to the Equity Shares held on Record Date, is not a round number (i.e. not in the multiple of 1 Equity Share), then the fractional entitlement shall be ignored for computation of Buyback Entitlement to tender Equity Shares in the Buyback for both categories of Eligible Shareholders.
- b) On account of ignoring the fractional entitlement, those Small Shareholders who hold 9 or less Equity Shares as on Record Date will be dispatched a Tender Form with zero entitlement. Such Small Shareholders are entitled to tender Additional Equity Shares as part of the Buyback Offer and will be given preference in the Acceptance of 1 (one) Equity Share, if such Small Shareholders have tendered for Additional Equity Shares.

VII. Basis of Acceptance of Equity Shares validly tendered in the Reserved Category for Small Shareholders:

Subject to the provisions contained in this Letter of Offer, the Company will accept the Equity Shares tendered in the Buyback by the Small Shareholders in the Reserved Category in the following order of priority:

- a) Acceptance of 100% Equity Shares from Small Shareholders in the Reserved Category, who have validly tendered their Equity Shares, to the extent of their Buyback Entitlement or the number of Equity Shares tendered by them, whichever is less.
- b) Post the Acceptance as described in Clause 20. (VII) (a) above, in case there are any Equity Shares left to be bought back from Small Shareholders in the Reserved Category, the Small Shareholders who were entitled to tender zero Equity Shares (on account of ignoring the fractional entitlement), and have tendered Additional Equity Shares as part of the Buyback, shall be given preference and one Equity Share each from the Additional Equity Shares applied by these Small Shareholders shall be bought back in the Reserved Category.
- c) Post the Acceptance as described in 20. (VII) (a) and (b) above, in case there are any validly tendered unaccepted Equity Shares in the Reserved Category and Equity Shares left to be bought back in the Reserved Category, such Additional Equity Shares tendered by the Small Shareholders over and above their Buyback Entitlement, shall be accepted in proportion of the Additional Equity Shares tendered by them and the Acceptances per Small Shareholders shall be made in accordance with the SEBI Buyback Regulations, i.e. valid Acceptances per Small Shareholder shall be equal to the Additional Equity Shares validly tendered by the Small Shareholder divided by the total Additional Equity Shares validly tendered and multiplied by the total pending number of Equity Shares to be accepted in Reserved Category. For the purpose of this calculation, the Additional Equity Shares taken into account for such Small Shareholders, from whom one Equity Share has been accepted in accordance with clause 20. (VII) (b) above, shall be reduced by one.
- d) Adjustment for fractional results in case of proportionate Acceptance, as described in Clause 20. (VII) (c) above:
 - i. For any Small Shareholder, if the number of Additional Equity Shares to be Accepted, calculated on a proportionate basis is not in the multiple of 1 and the fractional Acceptance is greater than or equal to 0.50, then the fraction would be rounded off to the next higher integer.
 - ii. For any Small Shareholder, if the number of Additional Equity Shares to be Accepted, calculated on a proportionate basis is not in the multiple of 1 and the fractional Acceptance is less than 0.50, then the fraction shall be ignored.

In case of any practical issues, resulting out of rounding-off of Shares or otherwise, the Buyback Committee or any person(s) authorized by the Buyback Committee will have the authority to decide such final allocation with respect to such rounding-off or any excess of Equity Shares or any shortage of Equity Shares after allocation of Equity Shares as set out in the process described in Clause 20 of this Letter Of Offer.

VIII. Basis of Acceptance of Equity Shares validly tendered in the General Category:

Subject to the provisions contained in the Letter of Offer, the Company will accept the Equity Shares tendered in the Buyback by all other Eligible Shareholders in the General Category in the following order of priority:

- a) Acceptance of 100% Equity Shares from other Eligible Shareholders in the General Category who have validly tendered their Equity Shares, to the extent of their Buyback Entitlement, or the number of Equity Shares tendered by them, whichever is less.
- b) Post the Acceptance as described in Clause 20. (VIII) (a) above, in case there are any validly tendered unaccepted Equity Shares in the General Category and Equity Shares left to be bought back in the General Category, such Additional Equity Shares tendered by the other Eligible Shareholders over and above their Buyback Entitlement shall be Accepted in proportion of the Additional Equity Shares tendered by them and the acceptances per shareholder shall be made in accordance with the Regulations, i.e. valid acceptances per Eligible Shareholder shall be equal to the Additional Equity Shares validly tendered by the Eligible Shareholders divided by the total Additional Equity Shares validly tendered in the General Category and multiplied by the total pending number of Equity Shares to be Accepted in General Category.
- c) Adjustment for fractional results in case of proportionate Acceptance as described in Clause 20. VIII (a) and (b) above, will be made as follows:
 - i. For any Eligible Shareholder, if the number of Additional Equity Shares to be Accepted, calculated on a proportionate basis is not in the multiple of 1 and the fractional Acceptance is greater than or equal to 0.50, then the fraction would be rounded off to the next higher integer.
 - ii. For any Eligible Shareholder if the number of Additional Equity Shares to be Accepted, calculated on a proportionate basis is not in the multiple of 1 and the fractional Acceptance is less than 0.50, then the fraction shall be ignored.

In case of any practical issues, resulting out of rounding-off of Equity Shares or otherwise, the Buyback Committee or any person(s) authorized by the Buyback Committee will have the authority to decide such final allocation with respect to such rounding-off or any excess of Equity Shares or any shortage of Equity Shares after allocation of Equity Shares as set out in the process described in Clause 20 of this Letter Of Offer .

IX. Basis of Acceptance of Equity Shares between Categories

- a) After Acceptances of Equity Shares, as mentioned in clause 20. VII and 20. VIII above, in case, there are any Equity Shares left to be bought back in one category (“Partially Filled Category”) and there are additional unaccepted validly tendered Equity Shares (“Further Additional Shares”) in the second category (“Over Tendered Category”), then the Further Additional Shares in the Over Tendered Category shall be Accepted in a proportionate manner i.e., valid Acceptances per Eligible Shareholder shall be equal to Further Additional Shares validly tendered by the Eligible Shareholder in the Over Tendered Category divided by the total Further Additional Shares in the Over Tendered Category and multiplied by the total Shares left to be bought back in the Partially Filled Category.
- b) If the Partially Filled Category is the General Category and the Over Tendered Category is the Reserved Category, then any Small Shareholder who has received a Tender Form with zero Buyback Entitlement and who has tendered Additional Equity Shares shall be eligible for priority Acceptance of one Equity Share before Acceptance in clause 20.IX (a) out of the Equity Shares left to be bought back in the Partially Filled Category provided no Acceptance could take place from such Shareholder in accordance with clause 20.VII of this Letter Of Offer.
- c) Adjustment for fraction results in case of proportionate Acceptance, as defined in clause 20. (IX) (a) and (b) above:
 - i. For any Eligible Shareholder, if the number of Further Additional Equity Shares to be accepted, calculated on a proportionate basis is not in the multiple of 1 and the fractional Acceptance is greater than or equal to 0.50, then the fraction would be rounded off to the next higher integer.
 - ii. For any Eligible Shareholder, if the number of Further Additional Equity Shares to be accepted, calculated on a proportionate basis is not in the multiple of 1 and the fractional Acceptance is less than 0.50, then the fraction shall be ignored.
- iii. In case of any practical issues, resulting out of rounding-off of Shares or otherwise, the Buyback Committee or any person(s) authorized by the Buyback Committee will have the authority to decide such final allocation with respect to such rounding-off or any excess of Equity Shares or any shortage of Equity Shares after allocation of Equity Shares as set out in the process described in Clause 20 of this Letter Of Offer.

X. For avoidance of doubt, it is clarified that:

- a) the Eligible Shareholders are advised to tender Equity Shares from their respective demat accounts/ folios in which they are holding the Equity Shares as on the Record Date;
- b) the Equity Shares Accepted under the Buyback from each Eligible Shareholder, in accordance with clauses above, shall not exceed the number of Equity Shares tendered by the respective Eligible Shareholder;
- c) the Equity Shares Accepted under the Buyback from each Eligible Shareholder, in accordance with clauses above, shall not exceed the number of Equity Shares held by respective Eligible Shareholder as on the Record Date;
- d) the Equity Shares tendered by any Eligible Shareholder over and above the number of Equity Shares held by such Eligible Shareholder as on the Record Date shall not be considered for the purpose of Acceptance in accordance with the clauses above; and
- e) In case of any practical issues, resulting out of rounding-off of Equity Shares or otherwise, the Board or the Buyback Committee or the persons authorised by the Board will have the authority to decide such final allocation with respect to such rounding-off or any excess of Equity Shares or any shortage of Equity Shares after allocation of Equity Shares as set out in the process described in Clause 20 of this Letter of Offer.

XI. Clubbing of Entitlement

In accordance with Regulation 9(ix) of the SEBI Buyback Regulations, in order to ensure that the same Eligible Shareholder with multiple demat accounts/ folios do not receive a higher entitlement under the small shareholder category, the Equity Shares held by such Eligible Shareholder with a common Permanent Account Number (“PAN”) shall be clubbed together for determining the category (small shareholder or general) and entitlement under the Buyback. In case of joint shareholding, the Equity Shares held in cases where the sequence of the PANs of the joint shareholders is identical shall be clubbed together. In case of Eligible Shareholders holding physical shares, where the sequence of PANs is identical and where the PANs of all joint shareholders are not available, the Registrar to the Buyback will check the sequence of the names of the joint holders and club together the Equity Shares held in such cases where the sequence of the PANs and name of joint shareholders are identical. The shareholding of institutional investors like mutual funds, insurance companies, foreign institutional investors/ foreign portfolio investors etc. with common PAN are not proposed to be clubbed together for determining their entitlement and will be considered separately, where these Equity Shares are held for different schemes/ sub-accounts and have a different demat account nomenclature based on information prepared by the Registrar to the Buyback as per the shareholder records received from the depositories. Further, the Equity Shares held under the category of “clearing members” or “corporate body margin account” or “corporate body – broker” as per the beneficial position data as on Record Date with common PAN are not proposed to be clubbed together for determining their entitlement and will be considered separately, where these Equity Shares are assumed to be held on behalf of clients.

21. PROCEDURE FOR TENDER OFFER AND SETTLEMENT

- I. The Buyback is open to all Eligible Shareholders / beneficial owners of the Company, i.e., the shareholders who on the Record Date were holding Equity Shares either in physical form (“**Physical Shares**”) and the beneficial owners who on the Record Date were holding Equity Shares in the dematerialized form (“**Demat Shares**”) (such shareholders are referred to as the (“Eligible Shareholders”). The Company proposes to effect the Buyback through a tender offer route through Stock Exchange Mechanism, on a proportionate basis. The Letter of Offer and Tender Form, outlining the terms of the Buyback as well as the detailed disclosures as specified in the Buyback Regulations, will be e-mailed/dispatched to Eligible Shareholders whose names appear on the register of members of the Company, or who are beneficial owners of Equity Shares as per the records of Depositories, on the Record Date, as per the SEBI Buyback Regulations and such other circulars or notifications, as may be applicable.
- II. The Letter of Offer, shall be sent through electronic means to Eligible Shareholder(s) who have registered their email ids with the Depositories / the Company, and for those Eligible Shareholder(s) who have not registered their email ids with the Depositories / the Company, the Letter of Offer shall be dispatched through physical mode by registered post/ speed post/ courier. In case of non-receipt of Letter of Offer and the Tender Form, please follow the procedure mentioned in Clause 21 of this LOF.
- III. The Company will not accept any Equity Shares offered in the Buyback where the title of shares is under dispute or which are under any restraint order of a court or such similar authority for transfer/ sale of such Equity Shares or where loss of share certificates(s) has been notified to the Company and the duplicate share certificates have not been issued either due to such request being under process as per the provisions of law or otherwise not clear or where any other restraint subsists. In accordance with Regulation 24(v) of the SEBI Buyback Regulations, the Company shall not buyback locked-in Equity Shares and non-transferable Equity Shares until the pendency of the lock-in or until such Equity Shares become transferable. The Company shall accept all the Equity Shares validly tendered in the Buyback by Eligible Shareholders, on the basis of their Buyback Entitlement as on the Record Date.

- IV. An unregistered shareholder holding physical shares may also tender his shares for Buyback by submitting the duly executed transfer deed for transfer of shares, purchased prior to Record Date, in his name, along with the offer form, copy of his PAN card and of the person from whom he has purchased shares and other relevant documents as required for transfer, if any.
- V. Eligible Shareholders will have to transfer their Equity Shares from the same demat account in which they were holding such Equity Shares (as on the Record Date), and in case of multiple demat accounts, Eligible Shareholders are required to tender the applications separately from each demat account. In case of any changes in the demat account in which the Equity Shares were held (as on Record Date), such Eligible Shareholders should provide sufficient proof of the same to the Registrar to the Buyback and such tendered Equity Shares may be accepted subject to appropriate verification and validation by the Registrar to the Buyback. The Board or the Buyback Committee authorised by the Board will have the authority to decide such final allocation in case of non-receipt of sufficient proof by such Eligible Shareholder.
- VI. As disclosed in Clause 20 (Process and Methodology of Buyback) above, the Equity Shares proposed to be bought as a part of the Buyback are divided into 2 (two) categories; (i) Reserved Category for Small Shareholders, and (ii) the General Category for other Eligible Shareholders; and the Buyback Entitlement of an Eligible Shareholder in each category shall be calculated accordingly.
- VII. After accepting the Equity Shares tendered on the basis of Buyback Entitlement, Equity Shares left to be bought as a part of the Buyback, if any, in one category shall first be accepted, in proportion to the Equity Shares tendered, over and above their Buyback Entitlement, by Eligible Shareholders in that category, and thereafter, from Eligible Shareholders who have tendered over and above their Buyback Entitlement, in any other category.
- VIII. Eligible Shareholders' participation in the Buyback is voluntary. Eligible Shareholders may opt to participate in part or in full and receive cash in lieu of the Equity Shares accepted under the Buyback or they may opt not to participate and enjoy a resultant increase in their percentage shareholding, after the completion of the Buyback, without any additional investment. Eligible Shareholders may also tender a part of their Buyback Entitlement. Eligible Shareholders also have the option of tendering Additional Equity Shares (over and above their Buyback Entitlement but not more than their shareholding as on Record Date) and participate in the shortfall created due to non-participation of some other Eligible Shareholders, if any. The Acceptance of any Equity Shares tendered in excess of the Buyback Entitlement by the Eligible Shareholder shall be in terms of procedure outlined in this Letter of Offer.
- IX. The maximum number of Equity Shares that can be tendered under the Buyback by any Eligible Shareholder cannot exceed the number of Equity Shares held by such Eligible Shareholder as on the Record Date. In case the Eligible Shareholder holds Equity Shares through multiple demat accounts, the tender through a demat account cannot exceed the number of Equity Shares held in that demat account.
- X. The Buyback shall be implemented using the "Mechanism for acquisition of shares through Stock Exchange" notified by SEBI vide SEBI Circulars and following the procedure prescribed in the Act and the SEBI Buyback Regulations, and as may be determined by the Board (including the Buyback Committee authorized to complete the formalities of the Buyback) and on such terms and conditions as may be permitted by law from time to time.
- XI. Please note that Eligible Shareholder(s) who intend to participate in the Buyback will be required to approach their respective Seller Member(s) (along with the complete set of documents for verification procedures in case of Equity Shares held in physical form) and have to ensure that their bid is entered by their respective Seller Member(s) in the electronic platform to be made available by BSE before the Buyback Closing Date. The Company shall accept Equity Shares validly tendered by the Eligible Shareholder(s) in the Buyback on the basis of their shareholding as on the Record Date and the Buyback Entitlement. Eligible Shareholder (s) who intend to participate in the Buyback using the "plain paper" option as mentioned above are advised to confirm their Buyback Entitlement from the Registrar to the Buyback, before participating in the Buyback.
- XII. The acceptance of the Buyback made by the Company is entirely at the discretion of the Eligible Shareholders of the Company. The Company does not accept any responsibility for the decision of any Eligible Shareholder to either participate or to not participate in the Buyback. The Company will not be responsible in any manner for any loss of Equity Share certificate(s) and other documents during transit and the Eligible Shareholders are advised to adequately safeguard their interest in this regard.
- XIII. For implementation of the Buyback, the Company has appointed Choice Equity Broking Private Limited as the registered broker to the Company (the "Company's Broker") to facilitate the process of tendering of Equity Shares through the stock exchange mechanism for the Buyback and through whom the purchases and settlements on account of the Buyback would be made by the Company. XIV. The Company will request BSE Limited (“**BSE**”), who shall be the designated stock exchange for the purpose of this Buyback to provide a separate Acquisition Window to facilitate placing of sell orders by Eligible Shareholders who wish to tender their Equity Shares in the Buyback. The details of the Acquisition Window will be specified by BSE from time to time.

XV. In the event Seller Member(s) of any Eligible Shareholder is not registered with BSE as a trading member / stock broker, then that Eligible Shareholder can approach any BSE registered stock broker and can register himself by using quick unique client code (“UCC”) facility through that BSE registered stock broker (after submitting all details as may be required by such BSE registered stock broker in compliance with applicable law). In case the Eligible Shareholder is unable to register himself by using quick UCC facility through any other BSE registered Stock broker, then that Eligible Shareholder may approach the Company’s Broker, to place their bids, by using UCC facility after submitting requisite documents.

XVI. All Eligible Shareholders, through their respective Seller Member(s) will be eligible and responsible to place orders in the Acquisition Window.

XVII. During the Tendering Period, the order for selling the Equity Shares will be placed in the Acquisition Window by the Eligible Shareholders through their respective Seller Member(s) during normal trading hours of the secondary market. The Seller Member can enter orders for Demat Shares as well as Physical Shares. In the tendering process, the Company’s Broker may also process the orders received from the Eligible Shareholders after Eligible Shareholders have completed their KYC requirement as required by the Company’s Broker.

XVIII. The Buyback from the Eligible Shareholders who are residents outside India including foreign corporate bodies (including erstwhile overseas corporate bodies), foreign portfolio investors, non-resident Indians, members of foreign nationality, if any, shall be subject to the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 and rules and regulations framed thereunder, if any, Income Tax Act, 1961 and rules and regulations framed thereunder, as applicable, and also subject to the receipt/provision by such Eligible Shareholders of such approvals, if and to the extent necessary or required from concerned authorities including, but not limited to, approvals from the Reserve Bank of India under the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 and rules and regulations framed thereunder, if any.

XIX. The reporting requirements for Non-Resident Shareholders under Reserve Bank of India, Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999, as amended and any other rules, regulations, guidelines, for remittance of funds, shall be made by the Eligible Shareholder and/or the Seller Member through which the Equity Shareholder places the bid.

XX. Modification/ cancellation of orders and multiple bids from a single Eligible Shareholder will be allowed during the Tendering Period. Multiple bids made by a single Eligible Shareholder for selling the Equity Shares shall be clubbed and considered as ‘one’ bid for the purposes of Acceptance.

XXI. The cumulative quantity tendered shall be made available on BSE’s website www.bseindia.com throughout the trading session and will be updated at specific intervals during the Tendering Period.

XXII. All documents sent by the Eligible Shareholders will be at their own risk. Eligible Shareholders are advised to adequately safeguard their interests in this regard.

XXIII. Procedure to be followed by Eligible Shareholders holding Equity Shares in the dematerialised form:

- a) Eligible Shareholders who desire to tender their Equity Shares in the electronic/dematerialized form under the Buyback would have to do so through their respective Seller Member by indicating to the concerned Seller Member, details of Equity Shares they intend to tender under the Buyback.
- b) The Seller Member would be required to place an order/ bid on behalf of the Eligible Shareholders who wish to tender Demat Shares in the Buyback using the Acquisition Window of the Designated Stock Exchange (**BSE**). Before placing the order/ bid, the Eligible Shareholder would require to transfer the number of Equity Shares tendered to the special account of Clearing Corporation specifically created for the purpose of Buyback offer, by using the early pay-in mechanism as prescribed by the Designated Stock Exchange or the Clearing Corporation prior to placing the bid by the Seller Member. For further details, Eligible Shareholders may refer to the circulars issued by BSE and Clearing Corporation.
- c) The details of the Special Account of the Clearing Corporation and the settlement number shall be informed in the issue opening circular that will be issued by the Designated Stock Exchange and/or the Clearing Corporation.
- d) The lien shall be marked in the demat account of the Eligible Shareholders for the Equity Shares tendered in the Buyback. The details of Equity Shares marked as lien in the demat account of the Eligible Shareholders shall be provided by the depositories to the Clearing Corporation.

- e) In case, the demat account of the Eligible Shareholders is held in one depository and clearing member pool and clearing corporation account is held with other depository, the Equity Shares tendered under the Buyback shall be blocked in the shareholders demat account at the source depository during the tendering period. Inter Depository Tender Offer (“IDT”) instructions shall be initiated by shareholders at source depository to clearing member pool/ Clearing Corporation account at target depository. Source depository shall block the shareholder’s securities (i.e., transfers from free balance to blocked balance) and sends IDT message to target depository for confirming creation of lien. Details of shares blocked in the shareholders demat account shall be provided by the target depository to the Clearing Corporation.
- f) For Custodian Participant orders for Equity Shares in demat Equity Shares, early pay-in is mandatory prior to confirmation of order by custodian. The custodian shall either confirm or reject the orders not later than closing of trading hours on the last day of the Tendering Period. Thereafter, all unconfirmed orders shall be deemed to be rejected. For all confirmed Custodian Participant orders, order modification by the concerned Seller Member shall revoke the custodian confirmation and the revised order shall be sent to custodian again for confirmation.
- g) Upon placing the bid, the Seller Member(s) shall provide a Transaction Registration Slip (‘TRS’) generated by the exchange bidding system to the Eligible Shareholder on whose behalf the bid has been placed. The TRS will contain the details of order submitted like Bid ID No., Application No., DP ID, Client ID, No. of Equity Shares tendered etc.
- h) It is clarified that in case of Demat Shares, submission of Tender Form and TRS is not mandatory. In case of non-receipt of the completed tender form and other documents, but receipt of Equity Shares in the accounts of the Clearing Corporation and a valid bid in the exchange bidding system, the bid for Buyback shall be deemed to have been accepted.
- i) All the Eligible Shareholders who have tendered their Demat Shares shall also provide all relevant documents, which are necessary to ensure transferability of the Equity Shares in respect of the Tender Form to be sent. Such documents may include (but not be limited to):
 - i. Duly attested power of attorney, if any person other than the Eligible Shareholder has signed the Tender Form;
 - ii. Duly attested/ notarized copy of death certificate and succession certificate/ legal heirship certificate or probate, in case any Eligible Shareholder has expired; and
 - iii. In case of companies, the necessary certified corporate authorizations (including board and/ or general meeting resolutions).
- j) Eligible Shareholders who have tendered their Demat Shares in the Buyback may deliver the Tender Form duly signed (by all Eligible Shareholders in case Demat Shares are in joint names) in the same order in which they hold the Equity Shares, along with TRS generated by the stock exchange bidding system upon placing of a bid, either by registered post, speed post or courier or hand delivery to the Registrar to the Buyback at the address mentioned on the cover page of this Letter of Offer, so that the same are received on or before of Buyback Closing Date. The envelope should be super scribed as “Matrimony.Com Limited Buyback 2026”. In case of Demat Shares, submission of Tender Form and TRS is not mandatory.
- k) Excess Demat Shares or unaccepted Demat Shares, if any, tendered by the Eligible Shareholders would be returned to them by Clearing Corporation. If the securities transfer instruction is rejected in the depository system, due to any issue then such securities will be transferred to the Seller Member’s depository pool account for onward transfer to the Eligible Shareholder. In case of custodian participant orders, Demat Shares or unaccepted Demat Shares, if any, will be returned to the respective custodian depository pool account.
- l) The Eligible Shareholders will have to ensure that they keep the DP Account active and unblocked to receive credit in case of return of Equity Shares due to rejection or due to prorated buyback decided by the Company. Further, Eligible Shareholders will have to ensure that they keep the bank account attached with the DP account active and updated to receive credit remittance due to acceptance of Buyback of shares by the Company.

XXIV. Procedure to be followed by Registered Eligible Shareholders holding Equity Shares in physical form:

In accordance with the Frequently Asked Questions issued by SEBI, “FAQs - Tendering of physical shares in buy-back offer/ open offer/ exit offer/delisting”, Eligible Shareholders holding securities in physical form are allowed to tender shares in buyback through tender offer route. However, such tendering shall be as per the provisions of the SEBI Buyback Regulations and terms of the Letter of Offer.

- a) Eligible Shareholders who are holding physical Equity Shares and intend to participate in the Buyback will be required to approach their respective Seller Member(s) along with the complete set of documents for verification procedures to be carried out before placement of the bid. Such documents will include the following: the (i) the tender form duly signed by all Eligible Shareholders (in case shares are in joint names, in the same order in which they hold the shares), (ii) original Equity Share certificate(s), (iii) valid share transfer form(s) i.e. Form SH-4 duly filled and signed by the transferors (i.e. by all registered Eligible Shareholders in same order and as per the specimen signatures registered with the Company) and duly witnessed at the appropriate place authorizing the transfer in favour of the Company, (iv) self-attested copy of the PAN card of all the Eligible Shareholders, and (v) any other relevant documents such as, but not limited to, duly attested

power of attorney, corporate authorization (including board resolution/ specimen signature), notarized copy of death certificate and succession certificate or probated will, if the original Eligible Shareholder has deceased, etc., as applicable. In addition, if the address of the Eligible Shareholder has undergone a change from the address registered in the Register of Members of the Company, the Eligible Shareholder would be required to submit a self-attested copy of address proof consisting of any one of the following documents: valid Aadhar Card, Voter Identity Card or Passport.

- b) Based on the documents as mentioned in Clause 21. XXIV (a) herein above, the concerned Seller Member shall place an order/ bid on behalf of Eligible Shareholders holding Equity Shares in physical form who wish to tender Equity Shares using the Acquisition Window of BSE. Upon placing the bid, the Seller Member shall provide a TRS generated by the exchange bidding system to the Eligible Shareholder. The TRS will contain the details of order submitted like folio number, Equity Share certificate number, distinctive number, number of Equity Shares tendered, etc.
- c) Any Seller Member / Eligible Shareholder who places a bid for physical Equity Shares, is required to deliver the original Equity Share certificate(s) and documents (as mentioned in Clause 21. XXIV (a)) along with TRS either by registered/ speed post or courier or hand delivery to Registrar to the Buyback, at its address provided in Clause 18 herein above, on or before the Buyback closing date. The envelope should be super scribed as "Matrimony.com Limited Buyback 2026". One copy of the TRS will be retained by Registrar to the Buyback and it will provide acknowledgement of the same to the Seller Member/ Eligible Shareholder.
- d) Eligible Shareholders holding physical Equity Shares should note that physical Equity Shares will not be accepted unless the complete set of documents are submitted. Acceptance of the physical Equity Shares for Buyback by the Company shall be subject to verification as per the SEBI Buyback Regulations and any further directions issued in this regard. The Registrar to the Buyback will verify such bids based on the documents submitted on a daily basis and till such time the BSE shall display such bids as 'unconfirmed physical bids'. Once the Registrar to the Buyback confirms the bids, they will be treated as 'Confirmed Bids'.
- e) An unregistered shareholder holding Physical Shares may also tender his shares for Buyback by submitting the duly executed transfer deed for transfer of shares, purchased prior to Record Date, in his name, along with the offer form, copy of his PAN card and of the person from whom he has purchased shares and other relevant documents as required for transfer, if any
- f) In case any Eligible Shareholder has submitted Equity Shares in physical form for dematerialization, such Eligible Shareholders should ensure that the process of getting the Equity Shares dematerialized is completed well in time so that they can participate in the Buyback before Buyback Closing Date.

XXV. For Equity Shares held by Eligible Shareholders, being Non-Resident Shareholders of Equity Shares (Read with clause 18 "DETAILS OF THE STATUTORY APPROVALS"):

- a) Eligible Shareholders, being Non-Resident Shareholders of Equity Shares (excluding FIIs) shall also enclose a copy of the permission received by them from RBI, if applicable, to acquire the Equity Shares held by them.
- b) Eligible shareholders who are FII/FPI/FVCI should also enclose a copy of their SEBI registration certificate.
- c) In case the Equity Shares are held on repatriation basis, the Non-Resident Eligible Shareholder shall obtain and enclose approval letter from RBI/a letter from its authorized dealer/ bank confirming that at the time of acquiring the said Equity Shares, payment for the same was made by the non-resident Eligible Shareholder from the appropriate account (e.g. NRE a/c.) as specified by RBI in its approval. In case the Non-Resident Eligible Shareholder is not in a position to produce the said certificate, the Equity Shares would be deemed to have been acquired on non-repatriation basis and in that case the Non-Resident Eligible Shareholder shall submit a consent letter addressed to the Company allowing the Company to make the payment on a non-repatriation basis in respect of the valid Equity Shares accepted under the Buyback.
- d) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Letter of Offer, If any of the above stated documents, as applicable, are not enclosed along with the Tender Form, the Equity Shares tendered under the Buyback Offer are liable to be rejected.

THE NON-RECEIPT OF THE LETTER OF OFFER BY, OR ACCIDENTAL OMISSION TO DISPATCH THE LETTER OF OFFER TO ANY PERSON WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THE SAME TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BUYBACK, SHALL NOT INVALIDATE THE BUYBACK OFFER IN ANY WAY. PLEASE NOTE THAT THE COMPANY SHALL ACCEPT EQUITY SHARES VALIDLY TENDERED FOR THE BUYBACK OFFER ON THE BASIS OF THEIR HOLDING AND ENTITLEMENT AS APPEARING IN THE RECORDS OF THE COMPANY AS ON THE RECORD DATE.

The instructions and authorizations contained in the Tender Form constitute an integral part of the terms of this Buyback.

XXVI. In case of non-receipt of the Letter of Offer and the Tender Form:

A. By Eligible Shareholder holding Demat Shares:

If Eligible Shareholder(s) holding Demat Shares, who have been sent the Letter of Offer through electronic means wishes to obtain a physical copy of the Letter of Offer, they may send a request in writing to the Company or Registrar at the address or email id mentioned at the cover page of the Letter of Offer stating name, address, number of Equity Shares held on Record Date, client ID number, DP name / ID, beneficiary account number, and upon receipt of such request, a physical copy of the Letter of Offer shall be provided to such Eligible Shareholder. An Eligible Shareholder may participate in the Buyback by downloading the Tender Form from the website of the Company i.e. www.matrimony.com or by providing their application in writing on plain paper, signed by all Eligible Shareholders (in case Equity Shares are in joint name), stating name and address of Eligible Shareholder(s), number of Equity Shares held as on the Record Date, Client ID number, DP Name/ ID, beneficiary account number and number of Equity Shares tendered for the Buyback. For further process, please refer to Clause 21. XXIII titled “Procedure to be followed by Eligible Shareholders holding Equity Shares in the dematerialised form”.

Eligible Shareholder(s) who intend to participate in the Buyback using the “plain paper” option as mentioned in this clause are advised to confirm their Entitlement from the Registrar to the Buyback, before participating in the Buyback.

B. By Eligible Shareholder holding Physical Shares:

An Eligible Shareholder may participate in the Buyback by downloading the Tender Form from the website of the Company (i.e. www.matrimony.com) or the by providing their application in writing on a plain paper signed by Eligible Shareholder or all Eligible Shareholders (in case Equity Shares are in joint name) stating name, address, folio number, number of Equity Shares held, share certificate number, number of Equity Shares tendered for the Buyback and the distinctive numbers thereof, bank account details together with the original share certificate(s), copy of Eligible Shareholders PAN card(s) and executed Form SH-4 in favour of the Company. The transfer Form (SH-4) can be downloaded from the Company’s website (i.e., www.matrimony.com). Eligible Shareholders must ensure that the Tender Form, along with the TRS and requisite documents (as mentioned in Clause 21. XXIV), reach the Registrar to the Buyback on or before the Buyback Closing Date i.e., February 11, 2026 by 5 pm (IST). If the signature(s) of the Eligible Shareholders provided in the plain paper application differs from the specimen signature(s) recorded with the Registrar to the Buyback/Company or are not in the same order (although attested), the Company/Registrar to the Buyback shall have a right to reject such applications. For further process, please refer to Clause 21.

Please note that Eligible Shareholder(s) who intend to participate in the Buyback will be required to approach their respective Seller Member (along with the complete set of documents for verification procedures in case of Equity Shares held in physical form) and have to ensure that their bid is entered by their respective Seller Member or broker in the electronic platform to be made available by the Designated Stock Exchange before the Buyback Closing Date.

The Company shall accept Equity Shares validly tendered by the Eligible Shareholder(s) in the Buyback on the basis of their shareholding as on the Record Date and the Buyback Entitlement.

The participation of the Eligible Shareholders in the Buyback is entirely at the discretion of the Eligible Shareholders. The Company does not accept any responsibility for the decision of any Eligible Shareholder to either participate or to not participate in the Buyback. The Company will not be responsible in any manner for any loss of Share certificate(s) and other documents during transit and the Eligible Shareholders are advised to adequately safeguard their interest in this regard.

XXVII. Acceptance of orders: The Registrar to the Buyback shall provide details of order Acceptance to Clearing Corporation within specified timelines.

XXVIII. Method of Settlement

Upon finalization of the basis of acceptance as per SEBI Buyback Regulations:

1. The settlement of trades shall be carried out in the manner similar to settlement of trades in the secondary market.
2. The Company will pay the consideration to the Company’s Broker who will transfer the consideration pertaining to the Buyback to the Clearing Corporation’s Bank account as per the prescribed schedule. The settlement of fund obligation for Demat Shares shall be affected as per the SEBI circulars and as prescribed by BSE Limited and the Clearing Corporation from time to time. For Demat Shares accepted under the Buyback, such beneficial owners will receive funds payout in their bank account as provided by the depository system directly to the Clearing Corporation. If such shareholder’s bank account details are not available or if the funds transfer instruction is rejected by the Reserve Bank of India (“RBI”)/ bank(s), due to any reasons, then the amount payable to the concerned shareholders will be transferred to the Seller Member’s settlement bank account for onward transfer to such shareholders.
3. In case of certain client types viz. NRI, foreign clients etc. (where there are specific RBI and other regulatory requirements pertaining to funds pay-out) who do not opt to settle through custodians, the funds pay-out would be given to their respective Seller Member’s settlement accounts for releasing the same to the respective Eligible Shareholder’s account. For this purpose, the client type details would be collected from the depositories, whereas funds pay-out pertaining to the

bids settled through custodians will be transferred to the settlement bank account of the custodian, each in accordance with the applicable mechanism prescribed by BSE and the Clearing Corporation from time to time.

4. For the Eligible Shareholder holding Equity Shares in physical form, the funds pay-out would be given to their respective Seller Member's settlement accounts for releasing the same to the respective Eligible Shareholder's account.
5. In the case of inter-depository, the Clearing Corporation will cancel the excess or unaccepted shares in target depository. The source depository will not be able to release the lien without a release of Inter Depository Tender Offer message from target depository. Further, release of Inter Depository Tender message shall be sent by target depository either based on cancellation request received from the Clearing Corporation or automatically generated after matching with Bid accepted detail as received from the Company or the Registrar to the Buyback. Post receiving the Inter Depository Tender message from target depository, source depository will cancel/ release excess or unaccepted block shares in the demat account of the Eligible Shareholder. Post completion of tendering period and receiving the requisite details viz., demat account details and accepted bid quantity, source depository shall debit the securities as per the communication/ message received from target depository to the extent of accepted bid shares from Eligible Shareholder's demat account and credit it to Clearing Corporation settlement account in target depository on settlement date.
6. The Equity Shares bought back in the dematerialized form would be transferred directly to the demat escrow account of the Company opened for the Buyback ("Company Demat Account") provided it is indicated by the Company's Broker or it will be transferred by the Company's Broker to the Company Demat Account on receipt of the Equity Shares from the clearing and settlement mechanism of BSE.
7. Eligible Shareholder will have to ensure that they keep their depository participant ("DP") account active and unblocked to receive credit in case of return of Equity Shares, due to rejection or due to non/partial acceptance of shares under the Buyback. Excess Equity Shares or unaccepted Equity Shares, in dematerialised form, if any, tendered by the Eligible Shareholder would be transferred by the Clearing Corporation directly to the respective Eligible Shareholder's DP account. If the securities transfer instruction is rejected in the Depository system, due to any issue then such securities will be transferred to the Seller Member's depository pool account for onward transfer to the respective Eligible Shareholder.
8. Any excess Equity Shares, in physical form, pursuant to proportionate acceptance/ rejection will be returned back to the Eligible Shareholders directly by the Registrar. The Company is authorized to split the share certificate and issue new consolidated share certificate for the unaccepted Equity Shares, in case the Equity Shares accepted by the Company are less than the Equity Shares tendered in the Buyback by Eligible Shareholders holding Equity Shares in the physical form.
9. The Seller Member(s) would issue contract note for the Equity Shares accepted under the Buyback and pay the consideration for the Equity Shares accepted, if applicable, under the Buyback and return the balance unaccepted Equity Shares to their respective clients/ will unblock the excess unaccepted Equity Shares. The Company's Broker would also issue a contract note to the Company for the Equity Shares accepted under the Buyback.
10. Eligible Shareholders who intend to participate in the Buyback should consult their respective Seller Member(s) for details of any cost, applicable taxes, charges and expenses (including brokerage), etc. that may be levied by the Seller Member upon the selling Eligible Shareholders for tendering Equity Shares in the Buyback (secondary market transaction). The Buyback consideration received by the selling Eligible Shareholders, in respect of accepted Equity Shares, could be net of such costs, applicable taxes, charges and expenses (including brokerage). The Manager to the Buyback and the Company accept no responsibility to bear or pay any additional cost, applicable taxes, charges and expenses (including brokerage) levied by the Seller Member, and such costs will be incurred solely by the Eligible Shareholders.
11. The Equity Shares accepted, bought and lying to the credit of the Company Demat Account and the Equity Shares bought back and accepted in physical form will be extinguished in the manner and following the procedure prescribed in the SEBI Buyback Regulations.

XXIX. **Rejection Criteria**

The Equity Shares tendered by Eligible Shareholders would be liable to be rejected on the following grounds:

For Eligible Shareholders holding Equity Shares in the dematerialized form if the (a) Shareholder is not an Eligible Shareholder of the Company as on the Record Date; (b) in the event of non-receipt of the completed Tender Form and other documents from the Eligible Shareholders who were holding Physical Shares as on the Record Date and have placed their bid in demat form (c) if there is a name mismatch in the demat account of the shareholder and PAN. (d) where there exists any restraint order of a Court/any other competent authority for transfer/disposal/ sale or where the title to the Equity Shares is under dispute or otherwise not clear or where any other restraint subsists.

For Eligible Shareholders holding Equity Shares in the physical shares would be liable to be rejected if:

- a) The documents mentioned in the Tender Form for Eligible Shareholders holding Equity Shares in physical form are not received by the Registrar on or before the close of business hours of the Buyback Closing Date i.e. February 11, 2026 (by 5.p.m.);
- b) If there is any other company's share certificate enclosed with the Tender Form instead of the share certificate of the Company;
- c) If the transmission of Equity Shares is not completed, and the Equity Shares are not in the name of the Eligible Shareholders;
- d) If the Eligible Shareholders bid the Equity Shares but the Registrar does not receive the physical Equity Share certificate;
- e) In the event the signature in the Tender Form and Form SH-4 do not match as per the specimen signature recorded with Company or Registrar;
- f) If the Share Transfer Form SH-4 is not witnessed; or
- g) Where there exist any restraint order of a Court/ any other competent authority for transfer/ disposal/ sale or where loss of share certificates has been notified to the Company or where the title to the Equity shares is under dispute of otherwise not clear or where any other restraint subsists.
- h) If the PAN cards (self-attested) of the Shareholder and all the joint holders, are not submitted with the form.

1. **GENERAL:** The Indian tax year runs from April 1 to March 31. The charge of Indian income tax depends upon the residential status of the taxpayer during a tax year. A person who is a tax resident of India is liable to taxation in India on his worldwide income, subject to certain prescribed tax exemptions provided under the Indian Income Tax Act 1961 ("ITA"). A person who is treated as a non-resident for Indian tax purposes is generally liable to tax in India only on his/ her Indian sourced income or income received by such person in India. Certain non-resident individuals, being a citizen of India are deemed to be resident in India upon triggering of certain conditions. Deemed residents would be liable to pay tax in India only on their Indian sourced income or income from business or professional controlled in India.

In case of shares of a Company, the source of income from shares would depend on the "situs" of the shares. As per judicial precedents, generally the "situs" of the shares is where company is "incorporated" and where its shares can be transferred. Accordingly, since the Company is incorporated in India, the "situs" of the shares of the Company would be in India and any gains arising to a non-resident on transfer of such shares should be taxable in India under the ITA subject to any specific exemption in this regard.

A non-resident can avail the beneficial tax treatment prescribed under the relevant Double Tax Avoidance Agreement ("DTAA") as modified by the Multilateral Instrument ("MLI"), if the same is applicable to the relevant DTAA between India and the respective country of which the said non-resident shareholder is tax resident subject to satisfaction of the relevant conditions including non-applicability of General Anti-Avoidance Rule ("GAAR") and providing and maintaining necessary information and documents as prescribed under the ITA as well as satisfying the relevant conditions under the respective DTAA including anti-abuse measures under the MLI, if applicable. The Act also provides for different income-tax rates applicable to the income arising from the buyback of shares, based on the residential status, classification of the shareholder, nature of the income earned etc. The summary of direct tax implications on buyback of equity shares listed on the stock exchanges in India is set out below. All references to equity shares in this memorandum refer to equity shares listed on the stock exchanges in India unless stated otherwise.

2. **CLASSIFICATION OF SHAREHOLDERS:** Section 6 of the ITA determines the residential status of an assessee. Accordingly, shareholders can be classified broadly in categories as mentioned below:

A. Resident Shareholders being:

- Individuals, Hindu Undivided Family (HUF), Association of Persons (AOP) and Body of Individuals (BOI), Firm, LLP
- Others (corporate bodies):
 - Company
 - Other than Company

B. Deemed Resident Shareholder — an individual being a citizen of India who is not liable to tax in any other country or territory by reason of domicile, residence or any other criteria of similar nature and has total income other than foreign sourced income exceeding Rs. 15 lakhs during the tax year.

C. Non-Resident Shareholders being:

- Non-Resident Indians (NRIs)
- Foreign Institutional Investors (FIIs) / Foreign Portfolio Investors (FPIs)
- Others
 - Company
 - Other than Company

3. INCOME TAX PROVISIONS IN RESPECT OF BUY BACK OF SHARES LISTED ON THE RECOGNISED STOCK EXCHANGE

- a) With respect to buy-back transactions that occurred till September 30, 2024, tax on buy-back of shares was governed by the provisions of Section 115QA of ITA, wherein the Company making the buy-back was liable to pay tax on the distributed income and the income arising to the shareholders on such buyback was exempt from tax under section 10(34A) of the ITA.

Provisions w.e.f. October 1, 2024

- b) Finance (No.2) Act, 2024 has made amendments in relation to buy-back of shares w.e.f. October 1, 2024, shifting the tax liability in the hands of the shareholders (whether resident or non-resident) and the Company is not required to pay tax on the distributed income.
- c) The sum paid by a domestic company for purchase of its own shares shall be treated as dividend in the hands of shareholders. No deduction is allowed against such dividend while computing the income from other sources.
- d) The cost of acquisition of the shares which has been bought back by the company shall be treated as capital loss in the hands of the shareholder and allowed to be carry forward and set off against capital gains as per the provisions of the ITA.

4. TAX DEDUCTION AT SOURCE ("TDS"):

The company is required to deduct tax at source at 10% under section 194 of the ITA in respect of the consideration payable to Resident shareholders on buy-back of the shares

In respect of consideration payable to Non-resident shareholders, tax shall be withheld at the rate of 20% as per the ITA or as per the rate in the respective Tax Treaty, whichever is beneficial subject to availability of prescribed documents by such non-residents.

5. SECURITIES TRANSACTION TAX ON ACCOUNT OF BUYBACK OF SHARES:

Since the buyback of shares shall take place through the settlement mechanism of the Stock Exchange, securities transaction tax at 0.10% of the value of the transaction will be applicable.

Caveat:

The summary of the tax considerations as above is based on the current provisions of the tax laws of India which are subject to change or modification by subsequent Legislative, Regulatory, Administrative or Judicial decisions. The note sets out the provisions of law in a summary manner only and does not purport to be a complete analysis or listing of all potential tax consequences of the disposal of equity shares. This note is neither binding on any regulators nor can there be any assurance that they will not take a position contrary to the comments mentioned herein. There can be no liability on the Company if any action is taken by the shareholder solely based on this tax summary.

In view of the specific nature of tax consequences, shareholders who are not tax residents of India are required to consult their tax advisors for the applicable tax and the appropriate course of action that they should take considering the provisions of the relevant Country or State Tax Law and provisions of DTAA where applicable.

1. That immediately following the date of this board meeting dated December 15, 2025 (“**Board Meeting**”) and the date on which the results of the postal ballot including e-voting for the proposed Buyback will be announced, there will be no grounds on which the Company could be found unable to pay its debts;
2. That as regards the Company’s prospects for the year immediately following the Board Meeting held on December 15, 2025 and the date on which the results of the postal ballot including e-voting for the proposed Buyback will be announced, having regard to Board’s intentions with respect to the management of the Company’s business during that year and to the amount and character of the financial resources which will, in the Board’s view, be available to the Company during that year, the Company will be able to meet its liabilities as and when they fall due and will not be rendered insolvent within a period of one year from that date; and
3. That in forming the aforementioned opinion, the Board of Director has taken into account the liabilities (including prospective and contingent liabilities) as if the Company were being wound up under the provisions of the Companies Act and the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016, as amended (including prospective and contingent liabilities).
