Belrise Industries Limited, incorporated in 1988, is a leading Indian automotive component manufacturer offering safety-critical systems and engineering solutions across two-wheelers, three-wheelers, four-wheelers, commercial vehicles, and agrivehicles. Its expansive product portfolio includes metal chassis systems, polymer components, suspension systems, body-in-white components, and exhaust systems. The company caters to 27 OEMs globally, with Bajaj Auto, Honda Motorcycle & Scooter India, Tata Motors, and Jaguar Land Rover among its prominent clients. With a pan-India presence through 17 manufacturing facilities, Belrise is strategically positioned near key automotive hubs, enabling rapid delivery and efficient just-in-time inventory management.

Belrise holds a 24% revenue market share in India's two-wheeler metal components segment (FY24), making it one of the top three players in this category. Products from this vertical, particularly chassis systems, remain critical for OEM partnerships, with high entry barriers due to stringent testing and validation protocols. In FY24, it processed over 60,000 tons of steel, reflecting its robust production capability.

Belrise leverages strong integration, 700+ robots, and IoT-enabled plants to ensure quality. 74% of FY24 revenue came from EV-agnostic parts. It's expanding into EV-specific components with a Pune plant for hub motors and chargers, backed by five patents and a Chinese tech deal. A recent acquisition of a Delhibased plastic molding firm boosts its presence with Japanese OEMs and high-tensile components. In Q1FY25, revenue stood at INR 1,780.9 crore with a 13.5% EBITDA margin. Belrise is well-positioned to grow across EVs, exports, and value-added products.
